## **Large Capacity Wells**

Current SVGMD policy:

Ordinance 18-01 Adopting requirements pertaining to new water well permits, Section 4: "Adopting requirements for reporting high-capacity inactive wells"

Questions for the Board to consider:

- What happens if an active well owner stops paying the annual fee?
- What happens if land with an active and/or inactive well sells?
- Should there be another registry to notify landowners that inactive wells might lose the ability to become active again?
- What happens when an inactive well owner wants the well to become active?
- What happens if an active well goes inactive and they want to become active again?
- Should there be a third category, such as "idle-active" (an active well that's not being pumped)? Maybe the annual fee is lower?

Current number of registered active wells: 65

Current number of registered inactive wells: ~24
