1) CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL OF DIRECTORS

3) **DISCUSSIONS/ACTIONS**

A. Professional Service Agreement with Larry Walker Associates, Inc. for Sustainable Groundwater Services 2022 Water Year Groundwater Sustainability Plan Annual Report

Tracey Ferguson, Plumas County Planning Director, shared that at the November Board meeting the Directors authorized LWA's proposal for the 2023 GSP Annual Report. This is the official contract, approved as to form by District Counsel. The contracted work is to be done between December 1, 2022 and April 1, 2023.

Director Roen made a motion to approve the professional services agreement with LWA and authorized the Chair to sign the contract, Director Roberti 2nd, motion passed, all in favor.

B. Construction Contract Agreement with Agri-Lines Irrigation Inc. for Irrigation Efficiency Demonstration Program LEPA Conversion of Irrigation System Equipment

Ferguson reported that the Board selected Agri-Lines as the approved contractor for the LEPA system equipment and installation at the August 15, 2022 Board meeting, but no official contract was written up at that time. This contract has been approved as to form by District Counsel and includes the original scope of work, as well as the additional spans and installation not originally anticipated. The total cost of the LEPA conversion contract with Agri-Lines comes to \$27,106.34

Due to Director Roberti wishing to abstain from the vote, there would not be a Board quorum to vote on this agenda item.
